Capital Campaign Public Launch

Update

Over 90% of the parishioners who took part in last fall's Feasibility Study indicated they were aware that renovations and repairs to our parish buildings and grounds are needed. They also offered their input on priorities, which we used in drawing up the list of projects to be done.

The goal of our Capital Campaign is \$950,000, which will take care of the most pressing needs. As you can see, the first phase of the Campaign has helped us to reach about one third of that goal.

We want to begin planning the first work projects shortly. They are: replacing the Church Entrance Bridge and the Side Stairways; the mandated removal of the Parish Center oil tank and replacing the original boiler; lastly, updating the Kitchen in the Auditorium.

Your participation in the upcoming meetings (dates to the right) and making a pledge will put us on secure footing as we begin to deal with architects and engineers.
