Pastor Opens Campaign

Fr. Jim spoke at all the Masses last weekend, announcing the start of the main phase of our Capital Campaign. The full text is on the parish website (saintmargaret.com). The important points are:

- 1) The proposed renovations and repairs focus on ensuring safety and security, increasing handicapped accessibility, saving energy and reducing operating costs.
- 2) The final prioritizing of projects came about from parishioners' input in the Feasibility Study.
- 3) Projects will be done in phases, based on the pledges that come back to the parish over the next three to four years; there will be no borrowing or going into debt.
- 4) The very first projects will be the renovation of the front entrance and the outside side stairs.
- 5) The pledges of parishioners in an earlier phase (before Christmas) were very

encouraging. Their actual payments allow us to take the initial steps of hiring an architect for these essential projects.

- 6) Other presentations are being offered in this latter part of January so that more parishioners can hear more details about the campaign, receive literature and ask questions.

Any contribution, over and above the usual support of our parish, is deeply appreciated and will be an expression of sacrificial giving in order to allow St. Margaret of Scotland to continue to be a place for people to come to deepen their connection with the Lord Jesus.
