Tuesday morning, before 9am mass, the contractors put jack hammer to concrete and by the end of the day, the bridge was gone.

Now that the front entrance is not available, the only entrances to the church for the time being will be the side stairways.

We have put together a list of

We are hoping that the summer months will be enough time to have a new entrance installed (which will not be a bridge).

Proposed Schedule of Work

PHASE I **Fall 2018**

Approximate Cost: \$450,000

- Replace the Church Entrance Bridge and Side Stairways
- Mandated Removal of the oil tank in the Parish Center and replace the Boiler
- Update the Kitchen in the Auditorium

PHASE II **Fall 2019**

Approximate Cost: \$290,000

- Update Auditorium Bathrooms and Replace Parish Center's Handicapped lift
- Add Handicapped Parking spaces and Re-coat & re-stripe the Parking lot

- Install new padding on the kneelers

PHASE III **Fall 2020**

Approximate Cost: \$210,000

- Update Fire and Security Alarm systems in the Church and Parish Center

- Replace the Sidewalks
- Replace the Windows in the Parish Center
