No longer interested in activities they used to enjoy

Tries to get minors alone

Changes in personality

Tries to hide use of technology

Is overly interested in spending time with minors

Gives lavish gifts to minors

Keeps secrets with minors

Is overly interested in spending time with minors

Does not believe the rules apply to them (or, does not follow rules or protocols)



Takes photos without approval, or asks minors to send them photos

Has inappropriate or suggestive conversations with minors

Commits physical and emotional boundary violations

Allows or encourages minors to break laws or rules

Demonstrates Aggressive or angry behavior

They Cast the First Stones



Last Saturday morning the masons arrived bright and early. By the time the 5pm Mass started, they had laid most of the pavers for the bridge.

As of this writing (Tuesday evening), the center medallion and sidewalk are to be poured on Wednesday. This work will make the main entrance to the church more attractive. You should be seeing the results while coming into mass today.

Shortly, work will begin on replacing the heating system in the parish center. The current oil powered boiler and hot water system will be replaced by an efficient gas fired system. The old tank will be abandoned, filled and certified.

Proposed Schedule of Work

PHASE I

Fall 2018

Approximate Cost: \$450,000

- Replace the Church Entrance Bridge and Side Stairways
- Mandated Removal of the oil tank in the Parish Center and replace the Boiler
- Update the Kitchen in the Auditorium

PHASE II

Fall 2019

Approximate Cost: \$290,000

- Update Auditorium Bathrooms and Replace Parish Center's Handicapped lift
- Add Handicapped Parking spaces and Re-coat & re-stripe the Parking lot
- Install new padding on the kneelers

PHASE III

Fall 2020

Approximate Cost: \$210,000

- Update Fire and Security Alarm systems in the Church and Parish Center
- Replace the Sidewalks
- Replace the Windows in the Parish Center
