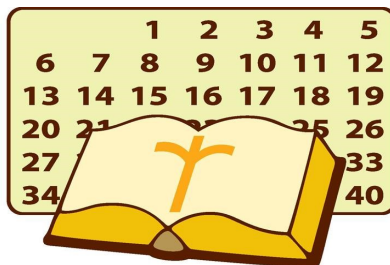

At least one of the parties must live within the parish boundaries, or be a registered member of the parish. Please call the Parish Center for an appointment. No dates will be set over the telephone.

BAPTISMS: Prospective parents should telephone the Parish Center about three months before the expected birth to discuss the arrangements for your child's baptism and enroll you in the required baptismal class. Baptism classes are held monthly on the 1st or 2nd Sunday of the month. The baptism date will be set at the time of the class. The child's birth certificate as well as the godparent's "sponsor certificate" (godparents must be Confirmed practicing Catholics) must be presented before a date is finalized.

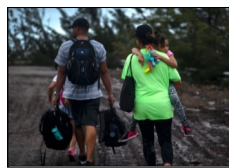
Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

For most of us, self-preservation is a very high priority. Even a soldier or martyr willing to die for a cause usually prefers to survive it. On a more ordinary level, parents and caregivers who make great sacrifices for their children still look for a “breather” during the day that belongs to them alone. The gift of life is precious, unique, and fundamental to everything else we have and all that we are. So it makes sense that we instinctively protect it.

The steward in today’s parable is a clear example of this instinct. From the beginning, we see he is not especially virtuous: he has been squandering the boss’s money (the opposite of what a steward is to do). The Master has found out, so the party’s over and he’ll have to pay for his dishonesty. Self-preservation kicks in, and he figures out one more way to play the system to save himself. In a weird way the steward shows absolute integrity through the story. He’s always looking out for Number One and he’ll do what’s necessary to stay afloat.

As a challenge to us, Jesus invites us to admire this fellow! Not for his dishonesty of course, but for his integrity. As Jesus says: If only the children of light showed as much investment in their way of life as the children of this world do in theirs! The unjust steward doesn’t waffle and weave but remains faithful to his ultimate priorities. His game plan makes more sense, really, than the person who recites creeds and participates in rituals of grace and redemption and then wanders vaguely into petty pursuits that have no meaningful connection to what they’ve professed. – *Fr. Jim*


