

Family members, please resubmit names for those who are ill. We will list them for 4 weeks, and then remove them unless told otherwise. Please note-due to privacy issues, we can include names given by the individual or a health care proxy only. Thank you. With the re-opening of elementary schools on the horizon, I want to comment on the next year of religious education at Saint Margaret. A number of changes have been introduced to offer better catechesis to our students and their families. I outline many of these changes here. Parents and youngsters should take note.

- Catechists are to be present for two evenings of formation held on September 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Twenty Minutes on Sunday mornings before the 10:00 AM starts on September 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Attendance at Twenty Minutes is **not** optional; it is required. Attendance is at least
- one adult with a youngster enrolled in Faith Formation.
- Attendance will be taken and it will be recorded. If there are three or more absences between September and May, adult and child are required to make up the absences after the close of the catechetical year.
- All families who have a child(ren) enrolled for the 2024 2025 year will receive a copy of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* at the start of the year.
- The *Catechism* will be used during Twenty Minutes (certainly when Msgr. Batule has the session).
- All families with a child(ren) receiving catechesis are going to be introduced to financial stewardship. We expect all families to contribute the treasure portion of stewardship each week. We have a lot of work to do in this area.

As for other things on the horizon, I call attention to these matters:

About two months from now (November 2<sup>nd</sup>), we initiate an additional daily Mass in our schedule. The Mass in question is on Saturday mornings. The time of the Mass is **8:30 AM.** Keep following the bulletin for more details.

As we have done the previous couple of years, we will have an official opening of the **Mass Book** in late October. This will allow parishioners to select dates for remembering relatives and friends at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. One Mass intention for each Mass is how we arrange for the remembrance. Multiple names are **not** added.

For a while now, we have been accepting Mass intentions for dates in 2025. We will continue to do that.

The Parish Mission is the weekend of September 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Al Barbarino will be with us at all four Masses.

The next **Holy Hour** is Wednesday, September 4<sup>th</sup>. It commences at 7:00 PM in the church. All lectors and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are expected to attend. A meeting in the pastoral center building follows the Holy Hour.
